### **Scholarships Available to High Schools Seniors**

#### JoAnn Link Hetzel Vocational/Technical/Trade School Scholarship:

- \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to students attending a vocational or technical/trade school
- Applicants must have a 2.5 GPA or higher and be a full time student
- Students pursing mechanics, electrical, welding, or surveying will receive preference for scholarships sponsored by Falkirk Mining Company, Coteau Properties Company and Coyote Creek Mining Company

#### Dr. Fradkin Community Service/Volunteer Scholarship:

\$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to students who excel in community service

#### Military Scholarship:

- \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to dependents of members of a North Dakota military unit/installation
- Applicants must have a 2.5 GPA or higher and be a full time student

## **Scholarships Available to Current College Students**

#### **Robert and Doris Alin Legacy Scholarship:**

- \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded to a student pursuing an education degree
- Applicant must be a junior or senior with a 2.5 GPA or higher
- Applicant must be a full time student and be employed at least 10 hours per week

#### Military Scholarship:

- \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to dependents of members of a North Dakota military unit/installation
- Applicants must have a 2.5 GPA or higher and be a full time student

#### James A. Guy Returning Students/Graduate Students Scholarship:

- \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded
- Applicants must have a 2.5 GPA or higher and be a full time student

#### **Professional Association Returning Students/Graduate Students Scholarship:**

- \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded
- Students in the following majors are eligible for scholarships sponsored by Professional Associations:
  - Accounting
  - Advertising
  - Agricultural Economics
  - Banking
  - o Business
  - Chiropractic
  - Communications
  - Computer and Information Technology Sciences (including programing, data processing, web design, system analysis, networking, engineering, simulator maintenance, etc.)
  - o Economics
  - o Finance
  - o Graphic Arts
  - o Journalism (including related majors that support community print journalism)
  - Dietetics



# **How to Apply for Scholarships**

Approximately \$100,000 in scholarships is available to students through North Dakota Dollars for Scholars. North Dakota high school seniors and college students are encouraged to apply. Applications are now open and being accepted online through April 1. Scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$2,500 will be awarded for the 2017-2018 academic year. Applicants must be from a North Dakota community with an active Dollars for Scholars chapter to qualify. Students from a wide range of backgrounds will be selected as scholarships cover a variety of areas including vocational/technical schools, military family, community service and continuing college students. Scholarship details and a link to the online application are available at northdakota.dollarsforscholars.org.

### How to apply?

- Create or edit your student profile by logging in under the **Students & Parents** tab at northdakota.dollarsforscholars.org.
- Remember the deadline for North Dakota Dollars for Scholars Scholarships is April 1. The deadline for local or national scholarships may be different.
- By editing your profile you will be matched to scholarships to which you meet the minimum eligibility requirements. You may be matched to Dollars for Scholars scholarships offered by your local chapter, state chapter and even national opportunities.
- You do NOT need to complete the Financial Info section or the References section of your
  profile to be matched to scholarships from North Dakota Dollars for Scholars. You may still
  apply for scholarships even if your profile is less than 100% complete.
- Next visit the My Scholarships section of your profile to view and apply for scholarships to
  which you have been matched. Click each scholarship to answer additional questions and to
  submit an online application. You must submit to each scholarship in order to be considered.
- Be sure to update your profile annually and reapply for new scholarships between January 1 and April 1.
