






Creating Your Account

- Click on "Choose This School" when your high school appears.


Creating Your Account


Student Profile: Basic Information






Student Profile: GPA




Student Profile: Class Rank










Student Profile: Parent/Guardian Information

Financial Information




- In order to be considered for needs based scholarships, you need to have financial info in your profile.






