### Whatcom Dollars for Scholars Scholarship Distribution

Your scholarship money will be paid <u>following</u> successful completion of your <u>first term</u> at college (typically in January). Checks will be made payable to the college with your name and student number listed on the memo line. Included with this check will be a letter to the financial aid office of your college emphasizing our intention that the award be used to help reduce your financial need and not replace other grant assistance.

#### To receive your award, please follow these instructions and comply with the deadlines indicated:

- We may send important communications regarding your scholarship to you throughout the year using the email address you used to apply for our scholarships. Please make sure we have a current email address on file for you.
- Please notify your financial aid or scholarship office that you have received a scholarship through Whatcom Dollars for Scholars.
- Your school may not apply your entire scholarship to the current term. Each college handles this differently, so please check with your particular college's financial aid office.
- Your scholarship payment will NOT necessarily be paid out in a manner that coincides with your tuition due date. We recommend that you prepare for the possibility that you may have to pay for your winter quarter tuition in full to meet your tuition deadline. In addition, once we receive all of the required documentation for disbursal of your scholarship, it may take a few weeks to process your scholarship check. Then, your school may take a few weeks to process the check on their end. **Please plan ahead and allow for this time**.

#### Your scholarship cannot be distributed until we have received the following:

- The **Scholarship Response Form** (p. 2) This was due in May 2015, so we probably have this on file already. If we do not, we will ask you about it when you send in your transcript/schedule.
- A **personal Thank-You Note to your scholarship donor** Again, this was due in May 2015, so we'll let you know if we need this from you.
- "Accept" your scholarship online. Use the username and password you created when applying for scholarships.

- Your transcript (grades) documenting your successful completion of a minimum of 10 credits. (does not have to be an official transcript)
- Proof of registration for 2nd term classes (10 credit min.) This is usually available online through your college.
