Guest Speaker: Mr. Dave Kozel, Professor of Engineering at Purdue University Calumet: Q&A all things relating to scholarships, college apps, FAFSA, etc

- Schools evaluate
 - Test Scores
 - School Grades
 - Types of Courses taken by the student (including dual credit and A/P)
 - Volunteer history, as it is a predictor of the future student as a hard worker, determined and giving back to the community.
- Scholarships
 - Read purpose of Scholarship and how fits with the student
 - Look at the main points of the essay
- Deadlines
 - Be aware so as not to miss opportunities
 - Apply to second choice schools on time also. As things play out, they may end up being your first choice.
- Reference Request
 - Contact your reference choice early, giving them plenty of time to write a reference for you. Keep in mind several students may be approaching the same person for a reference.
 - Provide them a reference letter or list of things highlighting student accomplishments. This aids them in writing the letter of recommendation.
 - Since reference request should begin 1st semester of senior year, it is common to ask teachers from junior year as they know you better. And you know them better.

- Read Application thoroughly for where they request the reference to come from. Common requests are:
 - Subject teacher as related to the scholarship.
 - Thus important for student to approach teacher throughout year so the teacher gets to know them.
 - **Club Sponsor**
 - Employer
- College Visits are Important
 - Being on campus clarifies perception from reality
 - Visit during the school day for a better feel of the campus
