If you are emancipated, you will have the opportunity to fill out your own financial information. <u>Click</u> here to determine if you are legally emancipated.

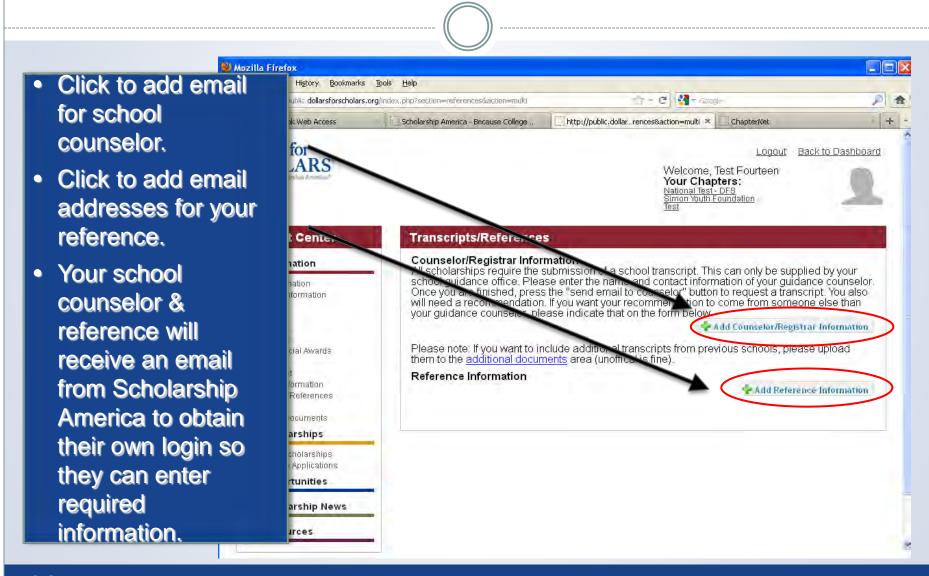
