- Must focus on supporting professions that promote agriculture, commerce and industry in North Dakota. This scholarship match is not available to associations that promote the use of alcohol or tobacco. Bank of North Dakota reserves the right to decline any partnership proposal that does not support the Bank's mission.
- Must have a board of directors and be in compliance with all state laws
- Can direct North Dakota Dollars for Scholars to distribute more than the matched amount of scholarships if it provides the funds
- Sets parameters such as year in school, majors and grade point average
- Assists with promotion of scholarship through membership notification
- Refers to scholarship as Name of association/North Dakota Dollars for Scholars Scholarship
- Must sign a commitment for three years to the scholarship
- Must pay scholarship funds annually by December 1 of the year prior to the award

The process:

Students apply for scholarships at **northdakota.dollarsforscholars.org**. All applicants are screened by the North Dakota Dollars for Scholars Scholarship Committee and it awards the scholarship(s). The recipient(s) name, college, photo and contact information will be provided to the association.
