# New Heritage LEVEL SCHOLARSHIP

A new Heritage Level scholarship recognizing long-time community member Eleanor Keane Johnson was awarded this year for the first time.

Leah Johnson, a swimmer and 2002 graduate of Fergus Falls High School, was the first recipient of the award established by Éleanor Keane Johnson – known to most people by her nickname, "Babe" - prior to her death in January at age 101. The scholarship reflects Babe Johnson's dedication to both her community and to health and

fitness. It will be awarded annually to a FFHS graduate who has a minimum grade point average of 3.0 and has been a member of the swim team for at least three years.

Born in 1901, Johnson experienced the tremendous changes that took place in Fergus Falls and in the world during the span of the 20th century. She saw the nation through two world wars and the Great Depression. She witnessed the sensation created by the arrival of the first horseless carriages in Minnesota, as well as the first moon landing.

She voted in the first election after women won the right to vote, and she never missed the chance to exercise that right. She maintained a keen interest in world and community affairs.

Johnson enjoyed an active life in the community throughout her 101 years. Her memoirs fondly recall summers at the lake and a childhood full of imaginative outdoor play. She attributed her good health to her active lifestyle, walking at least a mile each day and swimming as often as she could, even as she approached the century mark. In the Fergus Falls community, she is remembered for her kindness, generosity and sense of humor.

Johnson endowed the scholarship with guidance from Larry Dorn of Dorn and Company. Inc., who is a Fergus Falls High School alumnus and longtime supporter of Dollars for Scholars.

## PRESIDENT'S REPORT FOR 2001-2002

This year marks the TENTH year that Fergus Falls Area **Dollars** for **Scholars** has been able to award scholarships. The Board of Trustees joins me in thanking our donors for their contributions.

As a community, we can be proud of the fact that over the years we have assisted 224 young people with the cost of higher education by awarding more than \$148,172 in **Dollars** for **Scholars** scholarships.

Our endowment fund was enhanced this year by the addition of several new 544 Club members and a \$10,000 donation from Eleanor Keane Johnson, who established a Heritage Level scholarship. Fergus Falls Noon Rotary Club, Otter Risers Kiwanis Club, Noon Kiwanis Club, Lutheran Brotherhood Branch 8387, Fergus Falls Education Association and Fergus Falls Senior High School students donated money for special fund-raising projects. The endowment fund continues to grow toward our goal of \$544,000. Once the goal is reached, we will be able to provide scholarships in excess of \$27,000 each year.

Kevin Alm will be the next president of the Fergus Falls Area **Dollars** for **Scholars**. He has an energetic, capable Board of Trustees which will be working hard to build the endowment fund so scholarships can be awarded in amounts that are genuinely helpful in meeting the ever-increasing costs of education beyond high school. The Board of Trustees has set some aggressive goals for the next year. Look for a Fergus Falls **Dollars** for **Scholars** website. Look for beautiful new plaques listing all of the donors to the endowment fund. (The plaques will be displayed both at Fergus Falls High School and Hillcrest.) Watch for several activities that will be fun as well as fundraisers for the endowment fund.

It is an honor to live in a community that helps provide the encouragement our youth need to succeed in school and in life. The Fergus Falls Area **Dollars** *for* **Scholars** program gives each of us an opportunity to participate at our own comfort level – whether it be \$10 or \$10,000. # TEN YEARS AND GOING STRONG! 1992-2002


Ten years ago, Fergus Falls Area Dollars for Scholars awarded four \$500 scholarships to graduating seniors from Fergus Falls High School and one \$500 scholarship to a Hillcrest Lutheran Academy graduate. Since 1992, our local chapter has presented scholarships every year. Counting the scholarships awarded in 2002, 224 scholarships have been awarded for a total of \$148,172. That means that at least 224 students from our community have gone off to pursue their educational goals with some financial support from their hometown. The Board of Trustees is proud of this and hopes the award program will continue to grow.

**Dollars for Scholars** exists today because of Dr. Irving Fradkin, an ophthalmologist from the small

town of Fall River, Massachusetts. Dr. Fradkin's family were Russian immigrants, and he realized how much they sacrificed to allow him medical training. When he discovered that most of his young patients were not planning on going to college because they could not afford tuition, he decided to create a scholarship fund for his town. He canvassed the town, asking that each family donate at least \$1 toward a scholarship fund. The first **Dollars** for Scholars awards were granted in Fall River, in 1958.

Minnesota **Dollars** for **Scholars** was established in International Falls in 1962. Today, 114 Minnesota **Dollars** for **Scholars** chapters serve 234 communities statewide. The organization has headquarters in Minneapolis and is part of the Citizens Scholarship Foundation of America

Fergus Falls Area Dollars for Scholars was established in 1991 with donations of around \$60,000. Today the fund includes assets of more than \$310,000. The Board of Trustees plans to increase this fund to \$544,000. At that level, the fund would sustain scholarships in perpetuity and would assist the young people of our area with their education. Imagine what could happen if every family in Fergus Falls donated at least \$1 to our scholarship program!





Brotherhood. Besides being a fun evening for students and faculty, the project funded four scholarships for Fergus Falls High School graduates.




## KEEP A MEMORY ALIVE!
