



EXAMPLE ACTIVITIES & AWARDS/HONORS FOR MSF SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

Include your extracurricular Marshall High School “activities” in the “activities” section of your MSF profile (in addition to any activities you participated in outside of school). Note that activities that you did during high school should be listed, for a maximum of 4 years. *Do not include any activities you participated in during middle school.*

Example activities include:

Please note: Activities that are part of a graded class CANNOT be listed as an activity, except for awards earned at state competitions. Examples:

- Band (except for jazz, which is not graded)
- Choir (concert, show, Vocal Majority)
- Yearbook

Awards or Honors that you should include in the “Awards” section of the online scholarship application should primarily be those awards/honors that are academic and are not already included in the “Activities” section of your profile.

Examples of Marshall High School awards or honors:

- Academic “M”
- AP Scholar
- Capital Conference honors
- Laude levels
- WIAA Scholar athlete

Do NOT “double count” activities. For example, if you helped with a blood drive as part of your Student Council membership activities, include the blood drive with your Student Council information. The blood drive should not be listed separately.

DO include volunteer activities for organizations such as the Lions Club, VFW or American Legion, at your place of worship, etc.
