In his early years as a teacher he also coached different athletic teams and was most proud to have introduced football into the high school program. Carl was the coordinator of the Section V football officials and later became President of Section V Athletics. Carl was active in the Victor Lion's Club and St.Patrick's Church.</p> <p>MaryLou was also very involved in the Victor community. She volunteered at the Victor Library, Red Cross Blood Drives, St.Patrick's Church and worked in helping establish Victor's Serenity House. MaryLou's was an educator herself. Ed Ahonen Memorial Scholarship	To recognize a wrestler who has exhibited strong moral character, good sportsmanship, is a hard worker, is determined to do his/her best, is humble and respectful of others. Student should demonstrate leadership through example.
Farmington Chamber of Commerce	Student in need of financial assistance that resides in the Town of Farmington and is pursuing an education in vocational, trade school, or a college degree.
Finger Lakes Gaming and Racetrack Scholarship	Recipient will be chosen based on the following criteria: GPA, AP Classes, School Activities, Community Service, Awards, Work Experience, and Educational Objectives
Finger Lakes Lodge No. 139 Science Award	Awarded to 2 students who have excelled in the field of science. (one boy, one girl)
FLCC Excellence Scholarship	FLCC Scholarships are awarded to students who plan to attend Finger Lakes Community College. Students will have demonstrated academic excellence, community and school involvement and have financial need. Students must maintain a 3.0 average during their freshman year to be eligible for the second year of the award.
Frances Chan Memorial Scholarship	The recipient should be high in scholarship (high GPA), have an appreciation of the arts (music, art or drama), and show evidence of determination (experience facing adversity).
Gary R. Caron Memorial Scholarship	The student must be a senior planning on furthering his/her education beyond the high school level. 1. This award will be made to a student who: a. Has not lived with one or either his/her biological parents or b. Has experienced a lot of change and/or personal difficulties during his/her high school years (e.g. moving, changing schools, etc.) or c. Has found school a challenge and has strived to work to his/her abilities through extraordinary efforts. 2. The student should have demonstrated potential for a successful future.
Get it Straight Orthodontics Scholarship Award	Student must have a history of community service , in any area that is of benefit to others or contributes to society. Student must be a current or previous patient of Dr. Terry Giangreco, Dr. Ronald Cortese, or Dr. Janis Preston, who received orthodontic treatment (braces with maintenance retainers) in the Pittsford, Palmyra or Gananda locations. Plans for a 4 year college/university, community college or technical/trade school all qualify.
Hawkes-Keeff-Guinan Memorial Scholarship	Tom was a member of the class of 1977 who was killed in a traffic accident as a 15 yr old sophomore. Tom had a very quiet demeanor and contributed to many class activities without seeking the spotlight. This recipient should be dependable, honest, and pursuing a higher education. He/she need not be in the top of the class academically.
Helga Hufflepuff Award	Preference to those dedicated to leadership/mentorship in the Gay-Straight Alliance , or, failing that, otherwise demonstrated advocacy for marginalized communities (i.e. immigrants, women of color, women in STEM, etc.). Otherwise, existing selection criteria would fall to a student in theater, Quidditch, marching band, or on the math team.

IDI Billing Solutions Scholarship	A scholarship awarded over 4 years to a candidate majoring in computer science; information management; or computer engineering . Must be on VHS Honor Roll; must maintain a 2.8 average in college (reviewed annually); annually write a 500 word essay on educational experience and future plans to the IDI President.
Industrial Indexing Systems Scholarship	The criteria for this scholarship is: a. It will be awarded to a senior going on to further his/her education in the field of engineering .
Jack Thomas Martin Memorial Scholarship	This award is for a student who has exhibited a general interest in music and/or support of individuals with special needs .
James Cargnoni Memorial Scholarship	Awarded to a student pursuing studies in health/medicine, electrical engineering, or related fields .
Jerry Toomey Memorial Scholarship	The student may be a male or a female. The student must be involved in sports, especially the sports that interested Jerry, football, basketball and/or baseball . Nominees shall have demonstrated IMPROVEMENT in grades and attitude over the past four years . This student need not be a top academic student.
Jeanette L. and John M. Saxby Memorial Scholarship	To perpetuate the legacy Jeanette and John Saxby left in their lifelong dedication to education and community service. The selflessness they demonstrated in their teaching and business careers, combined with their commitment to their community, paved the way for the greater good of others. Community involvement for someone whose civic sense extends beyond school; consider a student who does not seek to be a "headline seeker" but is a leader in his or her own right; Selection of someone whose sense of motivation appears to be something that will carry throughout life; Scholastic ability average or above.
John Maloney Sr Victor Lacrosse Scholarship	The John Maloney Sr Victor Lacrosse Scholarship will be presented to a Varsity lacrosse player (male or female) who has displayed citizenship, hard work, and teamwork.
Ken and Ann Weigert Memorial Scholarship	Awarded to a recipient who is an academically, civic-minded student and has contributed to Victor Central School sports, clubs, or student government, displays school spirit and outstanding sportsmanship, and has active community involvement (community service). The student must plan on enrolling in a trade school or 2-to 4-year college.
Kenny Dan Reasoner Memorial Scholarship	This scholarship will support a graduating Victor senior pursuing higher education in the field of the Culinary Arts with the goals of becoming a professional chef .
Kiwanis Club of Farmington-Victor Scholarship	The Kiwanis Club Farmington-Victor Scholarship goes to the TWO outstanding seniors, who as a result of diligent effort, have achieved the highest percentage of improvement in their grades for the past four years and are college bound.
Kiwanis Club of Farmington-Victor Key Club Scholarship	Criteria: 1) Active Key Club Member for at least two years, senior year inclusive. 2) Demonstration of leadership, respect for others, and dedication to community service . 3) Candidate should incorporate the objects of Kiwanis into their daily lives - giving primacy to the human and spiritual, rather than material values of life and encourage the daily living of the Golden Rule in all human relationships.
Kiwanis Club of Farmington-Victor Leadership Scholarship	To recognize a student who has demonstrated outstanding leadership in the Farmington/Victor community, who has demonstrated leadership in an activity or organization and who has impacted others. The recipient should demonstrate maturity, be well-motivated, and planning to attend a two or four-year college.

Leon D. Robinson Memorial Scholarship	The student should intend to pursue a career in teaching . Emphasis will be placed on the following: Fitness of mind and body; Compassion toward others; Honesty and forthrightness; Personal commitment to ideals; Reverence of life.
Lucille Mahoney Sargent Memorial Scholarship	The award was established in June 1986 by J. Lee Sargent in memory of his wife, Lucille Mahoney Sargent, who was a 1950 graduate of Victor Central School. The following criteria are used to select the winner of this scholarship award. 1. Recipient must be a senior planning to attend college to pursue a four-year course of study . 2. Recipient must have been a good academic student with characteristics of good school citizenship, cooperation, good social intelligence, and self-discipline.
Madeline Hulbert Memorial Scholarship	The student should rank in top third and have demonstrated qualities of leadership, service, ability and character . The student must have lived in the school district and been enrolled continuously for three years preceding graduation.
Mary Culhane Clark Memorial Scholarship	The Mary Culhane Clark Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a student who plans to study nursing - just like Mary did Should consider: Financial need; Scholastic ability; Community involvement; School activity; Personality, motivation, maturity
Mary Weigert Carlson Memorial Scholarship	Awarded to someone like Mary Weigert Carlson - an excellent teacher; involved in sports; who combines an appreciation for learning with a love of sports ; who has a sincere dedication to education and community service, outstanding character and is well-rounded individual.
Michael Commisso Memorial Scholarship (VFD)	The purpose of this memorial scholarship is to assist a student who has demonstrated a strong commitment to community service to attend the institution of higher learning of his/her choice. The award is in memory of Michael Commisso who was a dedicated public servant.
Nellie S. Ranney Memorial Valedictorian Award	Awarded to the student with the highest GPA
New York Field Band Conference Scholarship	Each year one student who shows outstanding qualities of leadership, commitment and dedication both on and off the performing field is the recipient of this scholarship.
Olin and Frances Boughton Memorial Scholarship	Awarded to a student planning to go into teaching .
Ontario County Chamber of Commerce Service Award	This award is to be presented to a senior who has made a civic contribution to the community.
Outstanding Student Scholarship	To be awarded to 4 students from the graduating class who are exceptional students , have demonstrated leadership, maturity, intellectual curiosity, and are destined to make a difference in the world.

If no applicant is attending these schools priority will be given to a student planning to attend MCC, Alfred University, SUNY Morrisville, Jamestown Community College or SUNY Buffalo. The scholarship is awarded to encourage a qualified student to enroll in either a Computer Science/IT/Cyber Security field.
Ron Gillenkirk Memorial Scholarship	Awarded to a student entering the teaching or education profession. If no applicants fit the teaching criteria, considerations for those interested in baseball or the legal profession as these were Ron's passions.
Sally Sale Toomey Memorial Scholarship	Mr. and Mrs. Eldred Sale and Stephen Toomey established the Sally Sale Toomey Memorial Scholarship in March 1976 in memory of their daughter and wife who passed away on March 5, 1976. The award qualifications will be based on those used for the annual D.A.R. designee. The designee must have the following qualities to an outstanding degree: Dependability - which includes truthfulness, loyalty, and punctuality; Service - cooperation, courtesy and consideration of others; Leadership - personality, self-control, and ability to assume responsibility; Patriotism - unselfish interest in family, school, community and nation.

Sheila Dennis Memorial Scholarship	Awarded to a senior going on to further his/her education. The recipient must have taken at least one Business class and demonstrated a desire to succeed, despite obstacles. Student must have shown a consistent effort to work to the best of his/her abilities and participated/volunteered in community activities.
The Tyler Hutt Memorial Scholarship	This scholarship will be given to a student athlete who has come across life struggles. During these struggles (medical, personal) this student didn't give up. They stayed engaged, participated and helped their team in any way they could. This student should also embody the spirit of Tyler and how he lived by showing friendliness, positivity, having a caring nature, and being family-oriented.
Timothy Bauer Memorial Scholarship	The "Timothy Bauer Memorial Scholarship" was established in 1982. Awarded to a senior student who has shown through effort, attitude, and attendance a sincere appreciation for their education and the skills it provides. Trey Butler Memorial Scholarship	Awarded to a member of the Victor Robotics Team Devil Tech 1559 ; pursuing a 4-year degree in engineering or a technology-related major ; displays some or all of the following characteristics representative of Trey : kind, selfless, dedicated, compassionate, thoughtful, humble, good humored, respected, and liked by his teammates and mentors.
VCS Class of 1975 Scholarship	Awarded to a student possessing school spirit who has demonstrated appreciation of the VCS faculty and administration
VCS Class of 2024 Scholarship	Students should be involved in a school-related leadership role and a good role model in the school community
VCS District Administrators Award	To recognize those students who desire to pursue further education or a career in the vocational, technical, or trade field. Criteria to include: above average scholastically; personality, motivation and maturity.

Vera Brown Memorial Scholarship	Awarded to a worthy student entering the teaching profession . The qualifications are good school citizenship; acceptable scholastic achievement, cooperation, good social intelligence and self-discipline .
Victor Central School Alumni Association Scholarship	The Victor Alumni Association Scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior based upon their school spirit and loyalty to their alma mater - Victor High School.
