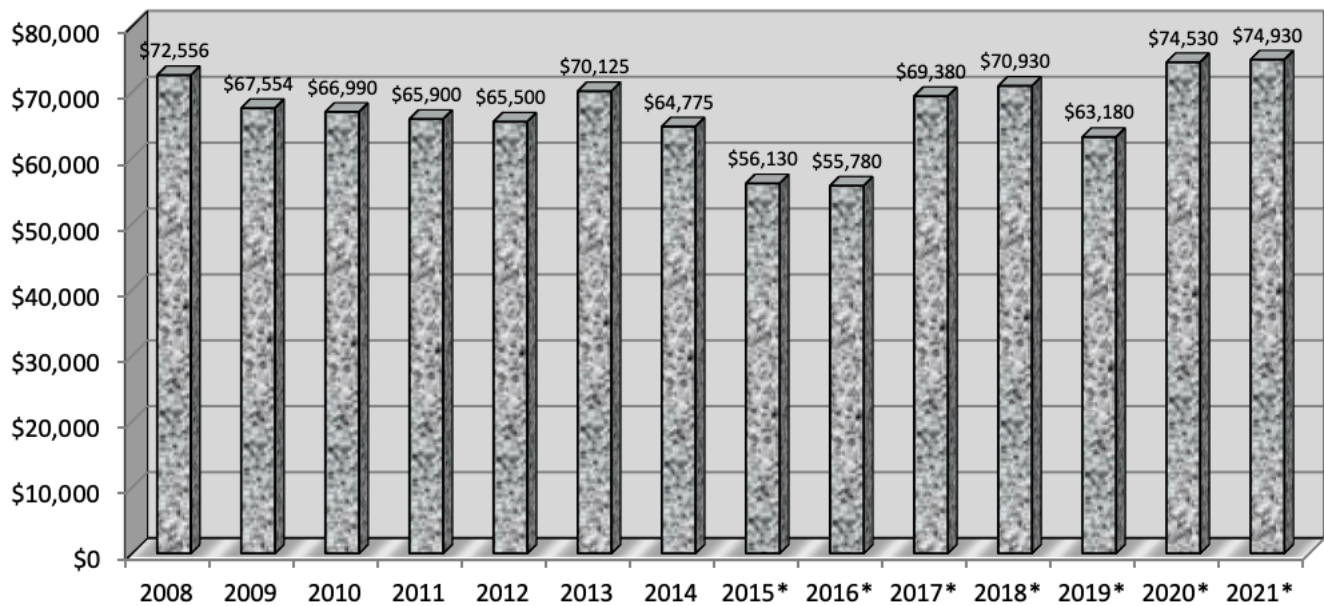
Fairport-Perinton Dollars for Scholars (DFS)
