

Two things to note under 'Financial Info':

1. If you are still **under 18 years old when filling out the application**, you must get **parent permission** to submit your application. To do this, you must input your parent email and submit a request to get their info. When your parent logs in, there will be a portion **in which they must grant consent**.
2. **"Financial Info" is not required for the parent/guardian**, but again, a parent must give permission through *this portion of the application* if the applicant is still under 18 years old. **For Local Dollars for Scholars scholarships Fairport scholarships are not need based – therefore, financial info is NOT REQUIRED.**
