


Scholarship America is partnering with other scholarship providers and scholarship search engines to provide students with access to those other resources using their one profile.

#### To access partner scholarships:

1. Log into your student profile by going to your chapter website and clicking on the Student & Parents section.







2. When you reach your profile dashboard, go to the My Scholarships section and click to search for new scholarships.




4. To access their scholarships that match to your profile, click the "Opt in ... " button.








5. Complete the information on the pop-up screen to create a Fastweb account and click the "Opt-in Now" button to search their list of over 1.5 million scholarships.
