The End of an Era...



While York City Dollars for Scholars, Inc. was busy with the work of awarding scholarships and supporting college-bound students this year, our Board was experiencing a significant shift as two of our most stalwart volunteers took their leave. After nearly two decades of contributing their respective skills and gifts, this winter Don Burkins and Brigitte Krause relinquished their roles as what seemed like permanent fixtures of our organization.

Don and Brigitte's journey with Dollars for Scholars officially began in 1999 when Don, who had recently worked with the Board of Directors in his capacity as a consultant skilled in strategic planning, was invited to join the Board by long-time friend, Mike Johnson. At that time, Mike held the position of Treasurer, and he encouraged Don to take on the role of Board President as founding member Kathryn Fourhman prepared to

relocate, leaving the position vacant. Don was ideal for the role, with his background in education and ties to the York City School District. Don and Brigitte knew something about college-bound York City students as their own daughter, Sonja, was preparing to head off to college. In Don, the Board gained an affable chief, adept at diplomacy and apt to expound upon any number of topics. As President of our small volunteer organization for a decade, there was virtually nothing that Don didn't touch, but he was particularly impactful in his involvement with the Awards Committee and the various iterations of the Finance Committee, which included budgeting and investment. In more recent years, having resigned as President in 2009, Don had taken on a variety of roles including quasi-historian and tech genius.

Brigitte, who consistently joined Don at Board Meetings from the beginning, has always been willing to lend her insights to conversations regarding a variety of the Board's projects and initiatives. After years of volunteering in classrooms and with the PTA. Brigitte found in York City Dollars for Scholars, Inc. another way to support York City students. Although she never did join the Board, she made an indelible mark as a member of the Academic Support Committee. Brigitte was instrumental in helping York City Dollars for Scholars, Inc. expand beyond just giving scholarships, as she worked collaboratively to bolster student success through sponsored SAT prep courses, Career Days, and college trips. Brigitte made a lasting impact through her partnership with Board Member Sue Krebs to develop and support York City Scholars, which helped dozens of students prepare for college over the decade or so that the program existed. The success of the current Scholars Program, which is in its sixth year, can be attributed in large part to Brigitte's long-standing dedication, creativity, and penchant for providing constructive feedback and timely encouragement.

Over the years, York City Dollars for Scholars, Inc. has benefited from the contributions of many generous, talented, and passionate individuals, willing to dedicate their time and energies to the worthy cause of making post-secondary education possible for York City students. The history of York City Dollars for Scholars, Inc. would be incomplete without mention of Don and Brigitte, and all that they have given as supporters of York City students, and as friends and colleagues. We were fortunate to have them as part of our organization for as long as we did, and we wish them well as they bask in the glory of retirement, world travel, and grandparenthood, among other fruitful pastimes.


