This year, approximately 2,162 students will graduate from Murrieta Valley, Vista Murrieta, Murrieta Mesa, and Murrieta Canyon Academy. Smaller donations will be pooled into the foundation's scholarship account and awarded to deserving seniors.

Donors have the option to establish custom eligibility questions to ensure their scholarship is awarded to student(s) who match their criteria. Donors will have the opportunity to anonymously select their recipient from mid-March through April 5. After April 5, recipients will be selected on your behalf based on your criteria.
