Phone-a-thon Scholarships

\$1,000 each, number awarded determined by funding

Open to TWHS Seniors pursuing a post-secondary certification, two-year degree (vocational/technical/associate) or four-year bachelor's degree.

Hendricks Regional Health "Relentless Dedication" Top Two Phone-a-Thon Scholarships

\$1,000 each, \$500 renewable second year, two awarded Granted to the two highest scoring Phone-a-Thon applicants.

Bill Compton Memorial Phone-a-Thon Scholarship

\$1,500, one awarded

Open to TWHS Seniors who are pursuing a traditional four-year or greater degree. Special consideration given to education majors and applicants with a strong record in community service. Applicants must apply for both the Compton Scholarship and a Phone-a-thon Scholarship.

Adelsperger Orthodontics "We Make Winning Smiles" Scholarship \$1,000, one awarded

Preference for this award will be given to current and former patients of Adelsperger Orthodontics who are entering any healthcare related profession. Community Service involvement is also strongly considered for this award.

Susan Begay Memorial Scholarship

\$1,000, one awarded

Open to TWHS Seniors pursuing a post-secondary certification, two-year degree (vocational/technical/associate) or four-year bachelor's degree. Award strongly based upon essay response. Applicants write essay regarding a personal experience where humor and/or a positive perspective helped them get through a difficult situation. Special consideration given to applicants with a strong record of community service.

Samuel K. Dickerson Memorial Scholarship

\$500, four awarded

Minimum 3.0 GPA required. Open to TWHS Seniors pursuing a post-secondary certification, two-year degree (vocational/technical/associate) or four-year bachelor's degree. Award strongly based upon essay response. Applicants write essay highlighting their personal attitude and effort in a challenging, difficult, or unfair situation.

<u>Future Nurses Scholarships – Sponsored by the Family of Linda Berg</u> \$1,000, one awarded

Minimum 3.0 GPA required. Open to TWHS Seniors who are pursuing an education and career in nursing. Special consideration given to applicants with a strong record in community service.

Stanley Joe Gibbs Memorial Baseball Scholarship

\$1,000, one awarded

Open to TWHS Senior Baseball players who complete their senior season in good standing and are pursuing a post-secondary certification, two-year degree (vocational/technical/associate) or four-year bachelor's degree. Special consideration given to applicants with a strong record of community service.

<u>Stanley Joe Gibbs Memorial Scholarships for Student Managers</u> \$1,000 each, two awarded

Open to TWHS seniors who have served as a TW athletic team manager for at least one high school season and are pursuing a post-secondary certification, two-year degree (vocational/technical/associate) or four-year bachelor's degree. Special consideration given to applicants with a strong record of community service. One female student manager and one male student manager will receive this scholarship. Two reference letters required.

Applicants must submit letters of recommendation from each of the following: 1) From the coach for whose team you managed. If applicant managed more than one sport, please request a letter of recommendation from the coach that can speak most directly to the service that you brought to the team.

2) From another person, outside of the coaching staff and outside of your family.

Stanley Joe Gibbs Memorial "Whammy" Scholarship

\$1,000, one awarded

Open to TWHS seniors who have taken an enthusiastic, energetic, and positive role in leading the student section at athletic events. Students pursuing a post-secondary certification, two-year degree (vocational/technical/associate) or four-year bachelor's degree may apply.

Edwin & Louise Gossett Memorial Scholarship \$500.00, one awarded

Minimum 3.0 GPA required. Applicants must plan to study any of the following career paths: Nursing (RN or LPN), Pre-Med, Psychology, or Christian Ministry (including Missionary). Community Service will also be considered.

William Hueber Memorial Public Safety Scholarship

\$500, one awarded

Minimum 2.5 GPA required. Open to TWHS Seniors pursuing a two or four-year degree in a public safety field*. Those majoring in Accounting, Computers, Business Degrees or other degrees with the intent to pursue a career with a Federal Law Enforcement Agency may also apply. Applicants must be free of any criminal convictions. School attendance and community service will also be considered.

*Public Safety fields include but are not limited to: Criminal Justice, Law Enforcement, Forensic Science, Fire Science, Emergency Management or Homeland Security. Examples of Federal Agencies include: Federal Bureau of Investigation, Secret Service, Drug Enforcement Agency, United States Marshals or Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms Enforcement.

Larry F. Rambis Memorial Excellence in Leadership Scholarship \$1,000, two awarded

Minimum 3.0 GPA. Open to TWHS Seniors who have held leadership positions, are passionate about their extra-curricular activity, and are pursuing a traditional four-year or greater degree.

State Bank Scholarship

\$1,000, one awarded, financial need considered, FAFSA EFC required

Minimum 3.0 GPA. Open to TWHS Seniors who are pursuing any 4-year business related field of study at an Indiana college or university.

Linda K. Szewc Memorial Scholarship

\$500, one awarded, financial need considered, FAFSA EFC required

Minimum 3.0 GPA required. Open to TWHS Seniors who are pursuing a bachelor's degee or higher at an Indiana college or university. Community Service will also be considered.

Tri-West Bruin Backers Basketball Scholarship

\$500, one awarded

Open to senior players on the Tri-West High School boys basketball team who finish the season in good standing and are pursuing a post-secondary certification, two-year degree (vocational/technical/associate) or four-year bachelor's degree.

<u>Tri-West Cheer – Melissa Atkinson & Jennifer Ellis Memorial Scholarships</u> \$500 each, two awarded

Minimum 3.0 GPA required. Open to TWHS Senior Cheerleaders who have completed all four years of a high school cheerleading program of sideline and/or competition team and are pursuing a post-secondary certification, two-year degree (vocational/technical/associate) or four-year bachelor's degree.

Tri-West Choir - Lance Kurihara Memorial Scholarship

\$500, one awarded

Open to graduating members of the TWHS Choir who have a minimum of two years of experience on the high school choir. Musical talent and/or performance are not factors; however, the recipient will have displayed exemplary dedication and commitment to the choir program.

Tri-West Quarterback Club Scholarships

\$500 each, two awarded

Open to TWHS Senior Football players who finished the current season in good standing, have been in the TWHS football program for a minimum of 3 full seasons, and are pursuing a post-secondary certification, two-year degree (vocational/technical/associate) or four-year bachelor's degree.

TWHS Soccer Boosters Scholarships

\$500 each, four awarded

Open to TWHS Senior (Boys and Girls) Soccer Players who have been in the TWHS soccer program for a minimum of three years and are pursuing a post-secondary certification, two-year degree (vocational/technical/associate) or four-year bachelor's degree.

TWYFL Cheer Spirit Scholarship

\$500, one awarded

Minimum 2.5 GPA required. Open to TWHS Seniors who participated in the Tri-West Youth Football Cheer Program between Kindergarten and 6th grades. Valid applicants pursuing a post-secondary certification, two-year degree (vocational/technical/associate) or four-year bachelor's degree may apply.

TWYFL Football Sportsmanship Scholarship

\$500, one awarded

Minimum 2.5 GPA required. Open to TWHS Seniors who participated in the Tri-West Youth Football Program between Kindergarten and 6th grades. Valid applicants pursuing a post-secondary certification, two-year degree (vocational/technical/associate) or four-year bachelor's degree may apply.

<u>Glen Tuel Applied Health Sciences or Nursing Memorial Scholarship</u> \$500.00, one awarded, financial need considered. <mark>FAFSA EFC required</mark>

Minimum 3.0 GPA required. Applicants must have attended TWHS for all four years. Open to students pursuing a 4-year degree which leads to a career in Nursing, Applied Health Sciences, or Health Information Systems. Community Service and financial need will also be considered.

<u>Glen Tuel "Tools of the Trade" Memorial Vocational/Technical Scholarship</u> \$500.00, one awarded

Minimum 2.0 GPA. Open to TWHS Seniors planning to attend an accredited institution or training facility which will lead to a career in a trade and/or technical certification. This scholarship is designed for the non-traditional, non-four year degree seeking student. Examples include, but are not limited to: agribusiness, automotive technology, construction management, plumbing technology, cosmetology, dental assisting, electrical technology, computer technician/repair, welding technology, x-ray technician. Other Requirements:

1. Good school attendance and punctuality

2. No school suspensions in current school year

Joseph E. Wallace Memorial Stem Scholarship

\$2,000, one awarded, financial need considered. FAFSA EFC required

Minimum 3.5 GPA. Open to students pursuing a 4-year STEM degree (Science, Technology, Engineering and/or Math.) Throughout school, family, and extracurricular activities, applicant should have demonstrated motivation and a high level of responsibility.

Candace M. West Memorial Scholarship

\$500 each, two or more awarded, depending upon funding

Open to TWHS seniors who plan to pursue any type of post-secondary certification, twoyear degree (vocational/technical/associate) or four-year bachelor's degree, and who have participated in at least one of the following:

- Swimming and Diving (as an athlete or manager),
- Football (as an athlete or manager), or
- Student Council

OR

• Also open to students intending to pursue a trade degree or trade certification.

TWHS ALUMNI:

Jackie & Larry Sparks Memorial Alumni Scholarship

\$2,250, up to two awarded

Renewable and increasing, financial need considered. FAFSA EFC required

The Tri-West High School Alumni Committee awards this scholarship to an undergraduate applicant who has completed at least one year of post-secondary schooling. This scholarship is renewable for a maximum of three consecutive years based on eligibility requirements. Applicant must carry a minimum 2.5 GPA and a minimum 12 credit hours per semester.

First year award is \$500.00 Second year award is \$750.00 Third year award is \$1,000.00
