CONTINUING COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY DEADLINE MARCH 11, 2022

- You **MUST BE** attending a 2 or 4-year College and entering your Sophomore, Junior or Senior year and were awarded an ESF Scholarship in your High School senior year
- Have a 2.5 Overall GPA
- Demonstrate financial need via your 2022-2023 FAFSA or CA Dream Act (*if applicable*)
- One letter of recommendation (*professor, teacher, counselor, boss, coach or advisor*)
- Write a 1-page essay
- NO Legal Citizenship Status required
- Apply annually

RECIPIENT REQUIREMENTS

- Attend Mayors Gala & one Esperanza annual event (virtual if held)
- No community service required in 2022
- Official Transcripts Verifying **2.5 Overall GPA**
- Official Proof of full-time enrollment verification (12+ Units)
- Write a Thank You Letter to ESFDFS Donors
- Submit the following information:
 - Name of college you will be attending in the Fall 2022
 - Address of the Financial Aid Office
 - College ID Number
 - Major

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:
