Step 1: Create a Profile - as early as your freshman year of high school!

- Go to www.stpeter-kasota.dollarsforscholars.org
 - Click on the "Students & Parents" tab.
 - Scroll down and click the maroon button "Click to Login".
- Click on "Don't have an account yet? Create one here."
 - Enter "Saint Peter Senior High" in High School Name. Click on "Choose This School."
- Complete Step 2: Fill Out Your Basic Information.
 - MAKE SURE YOU USE AN EMAIL ACCOUNT THAT YOU <u>CHECK OFTEN</u>. **DO NOT USE** YOUR SCHOOL EMAIL ADDRESS these addresses often have strong spam filters and do not allow outside emails.
 - o Read the terms and conditions and check the box to agree.
 - o Click "Submit."
- After submitting this information, an email will be generated that contains your login information. Log in on https://public.dollarsforscholars.org/ using your email and the temporary password. Create a password you will remember. You will need to log back into your account several times during the application process.

Step 2: Work on your Profile – keep adding details throughout high school.

- <u>Use the extremely helpful Student Guide to Scholarships for step-by-step instructions.</u> You won't regret it!!
- Once logged in, click on the "Work on Profile" button to get started.
- Specific Sections: Each item corresponds to the left-hand menu on the student dashboard.
 REMEMBER TO CLICK SAVE AND CONTINUE AS YOU MOVE THROUGH THE PROFILE TO SAVE YOUR INFORMATION.

- o **Parent/Guardian Info: REQUIRED** IF YOU ARE UNDER 16. To apply for a scholarship your parent must provide consent, or your application will be disqualified.
- o Financial Info: NONE
- Goals Essay: REQUIRED 100-200 words only. "Please describe your plans as they relate to your educational and career objectives and future goals." Be specific.
- o Unusual Circumstances Essay: if applicable
- o Transcripts: REQUIRED you MUST follow instructions in the Student Guide
- o References: NONE

Step 3: Apply for Scholarships – Feb/March of SENIOR year of high school.

- After February 15, log on to your student profile. On your dashboard page, look under the Yellow bar: My Scholarships. Click "Search for Scholarships". You will not match to any scholarships before February 15.
- Click the "Apply" button next to each scholarship listed to be eligible to receive that scholarship.
- You may be asked for additional information to determine further eligibility or there may be a question that is unique to only that scholarship.
- You must SEARCH and APPLY for ALL SCHOLARSHIPS listed BY MARCH 31 AT 11:59 PM. The system will not allow you to apply after this time, so plan accordingly.
