

Tri-West Dollars for Scholars scholarship applications open November 1. You will need to update your profiles in order to see the scholarships available and then apply online.

Steps to update your profile and take the Senior Scholarship Eligibility Survey:

1) Open the TWHS page, click on Menu, About TWHS, then Dollars for Scholars. (You can also access the site at: <https://tri-west.dollarsforscholars.org/>). Select the Students & Parents Tab. At the top of the page, click on "Senior Scholarship Eligibility Survey". This is a series of Yes/No questions that match you to scholarships for which you meet the criteria. This is required!

Next, go back to the Students & Parents Tab. **Click to Login.** Your login email should be your school email. Your password should be your school password plus the extension: @\$4Schs Use the 'forgot password' option if you can't gain access.

2) Under the Schools tab, change your 'Current Grade Level' to "SENIOR," and your 'Expected Graduation Year of High School' to "2026". You may be redirected to the "Dashboard" Page. If so, just click on the "Work on Profile" icon to work on completing your "My Information" tabs.

3) To apply for scholarships that consider Financial Need, input your FAFSA SAI (Student Aid Index) number under the Financial Information Tab. If you don't know your SAI, you may initially input 99999, but you'll need to replace that with your valid number to be considered for those awards. You must also upload the first and second page of your FAFSA Submission Summary form in the Documents tab. For "Document Type" you must choose "FAFSA Submission Summary". *View your FAFSA Report by logging into StudentAid.gov. Use your FSA ID to log into your account. Navigate to My Activity. Select your FAFSA form, View Submission Summary. Print or Save the Form.*

4) Before our closing date, Jan 15, thoroughly update your entire profile, (all tabs), including all your Activities, Awards, and Employment you have experienced or earned during your high school years. Your profile information weighs heavily on your scholarship application scores. THOROUGHLY FILL IT OUT!

5) Complete all tabs accurately and to the best of your ability. In January, once the 2nd semester starts, request Transcripts from the Guidance Department under the "Transcripts" tab. Tammy Smith - smithta@hendricks.k12.in.us . Guidance Department phone number is 317-994-4060.

6) Open "My Scholarships" tab. Answer series of yes/no questions, click "Submit."

7) Click the 'Verify Eligibility' Button. Scholarships you match to will appear in the "Scholarship Applications Ready to Complete" section of the page. Click on the "View" button to learn about each scholarship. Follow Instructions given for each scholarship.

8) For scholarships where the "Question" button is clickable, click on the "Question" button to input your essay response to the given prompt, and press "Submit." You must also click on the "APPLY" button for each scholarship.

Important Notes:

Scholarship applications require the completion of two segments:

1) Your essays:

- Type your essays in Word or Google Docs and then copy and paste them into your online scholarship applications. Be sure to click 'Submit' and 'Apply' when finished.
- Follow all directions, include your word count, answer the prompts accurately, without the use of AI, and as best you can.

2) Your Profile:

- Be as detailed as you can be when you complete the tabs of your profile.
- Concentrate heavily on thoroughly inputting information into the Activities, Awards and Employment tabs. These tabs count heavily in the evaluation process.

To have the best chance at receiving a scholarship, it is imperative that you submit detailed information in your profile tabs, and write grammatically correct and thoughtful essays. Our process is very competitive. Please take your time, follow directions, do **NOT** use Artificial Intelligence, and do your best work.
