

CSF Westfield Dollars for Scholars Completing the Student Profile

All Dollars for Scholars scholarships are applied for via the Scholarship America Dollars for Scholars Online Student Profile

Student Profiles may be filled in at any time but applying for CSF Westfield scholarships opens February 1 and closes at midnight March 15 of each year. Dates are announced each year on the CSF website.

CSF Westfield **requires:**

The student to be a **Westfield resident** pursuing **full-time undergraduate** studies.

The FAFSA SAI amount from the FAFSA Submission Summary **not to exceed \$70,000**

A complete and updated online Student Profile meeting CSF Westfield requirements.

The current scholarship year Submission Summary, uploaded into the online Student Profile by the **deadline date**

The current High School Transcript or College Transcript uploaded into the Profile by the **deadline date**.

Applying for scholarships after completing all CSF requirements during the open application period and by the **deadline**

The Online Student Profile may also be used in applying for Scholarship America and other third party scholarships which may require more sections than CSF Westfield requires for completion – check their requirements.

Eligibility Requirements for CSF Westfield Scholarships

- Westfield resident.
- Full time undergraduate student in the upcoming academic year (can apply up to 4 times).
- SAI (Student Aid Index formerly EFC) from the FAFSA Submission Summary (formerly SAR) of \$70,000 or less.

Students must do the following to be considered for CSF Westfield Scholarships






