



# Differing Scholarships/Changing Colleges



- Recipients of a MSF scholarship are able to request a late receipt of their scholarship award if they have not used it immediately after their high school graduation. The recipient has until the end of the Fall semester, one year after his/her graduation from MHS, to request the funds. The Fall semester end date will be the one published by the recipients chosen PS school. It will be your responsibility to submit your request by notifying us at MSF, P.O. Box 262, Milaca, MN, 56353 and listing the school you will be attending and the most recent address where your check can be mailed. This request must be made and completed in a timely fashion before the end of the Fall semester in question.
- If you change colleges, during your first year, you must notify us about the change by listing the new school you will be attending and your most recent mailing address. When the MSF receives the unused portion of your scholarship from the previously attended college, we will mail it to your most recent listed mailing address.
