**Knights of Columbus #2895 – 2 awards**

Students must have attended St. Anne's School **OR** be a member of St. Anne's Parish **OR** a member of a Knights of Columbus family. Student **must** actively participate in the Church and events of the Church. **Must** have a GPA of 2.667 or higher, with emphasis on participation in high school extra curricular activities.

**Green Mill Bar-2 awards**

- 1) Scholarship – Student **MUST** be a 3 season athlete **ALL** four (4) years of High School, who has maintained a 3.0 or better GPA.
- 2) Scholarship – Student **MUST** have participated in extracurricular activities (sports, Speech, theater, etc.)

**The Canopy Group/AXA – 2 awards**

Students, preferably (1 girl/1 boy) whose GPA is below 3.0 at the end of the 1st semester Senior year and have the greatest GPA increase since end of their Sophomore year. The GPA accounting will be done by the high school counselor. Also include a short essay on how you accomplished raising your grade point average, stating what attributes, skills and techniques helped you improve yourself in the classroom.

### **Le Sueur Rotary Club**

Students demonstrating "Service Above Self" through significant local community service, which may include service beyond the Le Sueur-Henderson area. Must graduate with a GPA of 2.0 or higher. Preference is given to students participating in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

### **Ed Gess Memorial Scholarship Fund**

Student pursuing a career in Education or Engineering with preference given to a student whose community service/involvement has been significant.

### **Ernest Denzer Memorial**

Student attending a 2-year community college/vocational school with preference given in the field of Agriculture or the Medical field.

### **Minnesota Valley Hospital Auxiliary**

Student **must** graduate with a GPA of 3.0 or better and **must be** pursuing a career in the Healthcare field, specifically – Nursing, Physician, Laboratory/X-Ray Technician, Therapist (Physical, Occupational or Speech).

### **The Bar**

Student **must** have been involved in 3 or more different sports during their 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade high school years.

### **First Farmers & Merchants Bank, Le Sueur – 3 awards**

Student **must** graduate with a GPA of 2.0 or above. Preference given to a student that is a customer of or related to a customer (Mother/Father, Grandparent) of First Farmers & Merchants Bank. Emphasis will be given to a student pursuing a career in Business or Agriculture.

### **HomeTown Bank, Henderson**

Student **must** graduate with a GPA of 2.0 or above. Student **must** be a customer of or related to a customer (parent/grandparent) of HomeTown Bank, with preference given to a student from the Henderson area.

### **HomeTown Bank, Le Sueur**

Student **must** graduate with a GPA of 2.0 or above. Student **must** be a customer of or related to a customer (parent/grandparent) of HomeTown Bank, with preference given to a student from the Le Sueur area.

### **Shirley Monahan Music Memorial**

Student **must** be actively involved in band and/or choir in high school with preference given to student pursuing a major/minor in music. Recipient will be selected with the help of Mrs. Pletke (Band Director) and Mr. Jacobson (Choir Director).

### **Matt Saxe Chevrolet Buick Scholarship – 1 award (2 options preference given to first option)**

(1) Scholarship available to any senior, who will be attending a 2 year vocational school/community college with an automotive focus (mechanic, auto body, etc). The recipient will be offered a paid summer internship at Matt Saxe Chevrolet Buick in Belle Plaine.

(2) Scholarship available to any senior, who at the end of semester one of senior year, has an equivalent of an A (3.67 or better) GPA and is pursuing studies in the field of business or agriculture.

### **Bolton & Menk Scholarship**

Student entering the field of Engineering, preferably Civil Engineering.

### **Del's Construction Company – Le Sueur-Henderson Leadership Scholarship**

Scholarship awarded through a separate scoring process to a graduating senior that has displayed outstanding leadership in keeping with the 6 traits – Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring & Citizenship of the “LSH Character Counts” program.

### **Mitch Thune Memorial 2 Awards available**

Student **must** be attending St. John's University or St. Benedicts in Minnesota, **must** be involved in extracurricular activities and **must** be a volunteer.

### **Schwartz Family & MIG Insurance Group**

Student **must** have a 3.0 GPA or higher and participated in at least 2 co curricular activities throughout their 4 years of high school. Preference given to someone who is currently involved in wrestling.

### **Time Burns Memorial Scholarships-2 Awards**

1) Scholarship to any senior going to a post secondary school who has demonstrated service to others through volunteering with primary preference given to a student who is currently involved with wrestling. Secondary preference to a senior who is going into construction trades, agriculture or conservation (wildlife or environmental) and has demonstrated service to others through volunteering.

2) Scholarship going to a senior who is going into construction trades, agriculture or conservation (wildlife or environmental) and has demonstrated service to others through volunteering.

**Angels Amongst Us Scholarships – 9 Awards**

*Fine Arts & Community Volunteer* – **must** be involved in Fine Arts and have a GPA of 2.0 or above.

*Love For Children* – **must** be pursuing a career working directly with children.

*Student Involvement* – **must** be involved in one or more extra curricular activities and have a GPA of 3.0 or better.

*Trades* – GPA of 2.0 or above and **must be** attending a 2 year college or vocational/technical school.

*Extra Curriculars & Community Volunteer* – GPA of 2.0 or higher, involved in 3 or more extra curricular activities in 4 years, and **must** be a volunteer in the community.

*Student Involvement*- Student must be involved in one or more extra curricular activities and have a GPA of 3.0 or better.

*Volunteer & Extra Curricular* – GPA of 3.0 or better, involved in 3 or more extracurricular activities, **MUST** have volunteered in helping with the community Angels Amongst US Fundraiser held in June of 2017.

Trades/ Agriculture- (2) Scholarships with preferences to any senior attending a Community College in the area of Trades with a secondary preference of a senior going into agriculture

Fine Arts-Scholarship for a senior going to a Community College- with a secondary preference of a student going into the Fine Arts

School Spirit-Scholarship for a senior who shows tremendous School Spirit, must have a teacher recommendation
