# IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS!!!!

*Parents, please read the following instructions to help you choose a camp for your child.*

**Notes:** Due to the circumstances surrounding the COVID-19 virus, we will not be able to have an awards ceremony this year. All forms will be submitted by email and postal mail (if necessary). You can also contact the office if you have questions.

**Please contact the individual camp you are interested in to confirm whether they will have camp sessions this year. Also, this 2020 Enrichment Camp Directory will be updated periodically, so please check the website often.**

Your child received an Academic Enrichment Scholarship that can be used at any of the listed programs. The total value of the scholarship is **\$250.00**. You **MAY** select more than one program as long as the total amount does not exceed the value of the scholarship. Special pricing may be available at participating camps for Jefferson Dollars for Scholars scholarship recipients **only**.

1. To complete your registration, you will need a **Camp Payment Authorization Letter**. This form is a double-signed authorization form that will be provided to you by your School Drive Coordinator or another school staff member. *You must have a copy of this signed form in order to receive the scholarship amount and to register your child without payment.*
2. Once you receive your Camp Payment Authorization Letter, you can choose one or more camps to register your child. **If you are interested in a camp that is not listed in our Directory and seems to**

**meet our criteria, you MUST contact the office for approval before enrolling your child.**

3. Please remember:

a. We do not fund sports camp, day camps, religious or Bible camps. **We do not fund Jefferson Parish school camps.**

b. You must choose a camp that falls under our “enrichment” criteria (camps that promote STEM, art, karate, etc.).

4. You will need to give your Camp Payment Authorization Letter to the Director or another staff member of the camp you choose.

This letter serves as our agreement to pay a maximum of \$250.00 of the camp costs.

a. If camp costs exceed the value of the scholarship, the parents are responsible for the remaining balance.

b. If you choose a camp and you did not use the entire award amount, you have the option to use the remaining funds at the same camp or you may choose a different camp.

c. If your child attends more than one camp, you will need multiple copies of the Camp Payment Authorization Letter. Please notify your School Drive Coordinator of how many copies you will need so they can provide them to you.

5. **IMPORTANT!!!!** Once your child completes their summer camp experience, you will need to complete a 2020 Summer Camp Report. Your child will receive a copy of this form and it will also be available online on our website. Please print, complete and submit this form along with pictures or videos of your child engaging in camp activities. **This form is necessary so we can continue to receive funding for our program. Please make sure you submit a completed copy before the end of the summer.**

*Padres, por favor, lea las siguientes instrucciones para ayudarlo a elegir un campamento para su hijo.*

**Notas:** Debido a las circunstancias que rodean al virus COVID-19, no tendremos una ceremonia de premiación este año. Todos los formularios se enviarán por correo electrónico y correo postal (si es necesario). También puede comunicarse con la oficina si tiene preguntas.

**Póngase en contacto con el campamento individual que le interesa para confirmar si tendrán sesiones de campamento este año. Además, el Directorio de Campamentos de Enriquecimiento 2020 se actualizará periódicamente, por lo tanto, consulte el sitio web con frecuencia.**

Su hijo recibió una Beca de Enriquecimiento Académico que se puede utilizar en cualquiera de los programas enumerados y algunos otros que no figuran en la lista. 4. Deberá entregar su Carta de Autorización de Pago de Campamento al Director u otro miembro del personal del campamento que elija. Esta carta sirve como nuestro acuerdo para pagar un máximo de \$250.00 de los costos del campamento.
  - a. Si el costo del campamento excede el valor de la beca, los padres son responsables del saldo restante.
  - b. Si elige un campamento y no utiliza el monto total del premio, tiene la opción de usar los fondos restantes en el mismo campamento o puede elegir un campamento diferente.
  - c. Si su hijo asiste a más de un campamento, varias copias de la Carta de Autorización de Pago del Campamento. Notifique a su coordinador de Drive School de cuántas copias necesitará para que puedan imprimir el monto correcto por usted.
