

## **OGILVIE ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIPS**

## Deadline to Apply: April 1, 2024 at 11:59pm To apply:

- 1. Go to the CSF-Dollars for Scholars website www.ogilvie.dollarsforscholars.org
- 2. Click on the Students/Parents section on the top menu
- 3. Select Click to Login to begin/update your application. Click on the "Completing the Student Profile" on the website for step by step instructions. Note exceptions below.

## NOTE TO THE APPLICANT:

To be considered for a scholarship, applicants are **required** to apply through the online Student Profile process. You may use your profile previously set up while in high school or college. If you do not remember your login information, you can select the "Forgot Password" option. This will only work if you still have access to the email account used to set-up your profile. If you no longer have access to that email account, then you may need to start a new profile. Be sure to review & update your information with any changes (address, phone numbers, email address, college information, etc). It is recommended that you DO NOT USE your school email account.

<u>The following sections are **NOT** required to be completed in the Student Profile for the Alumni Scholarships</u>: Test Scores; Activities; Awards; Employment; Parent/Guardian Info; Financial Info; Essay Sections (\*\*The required essay needs to be uploaded into the Documents Section as indicated below); References. \*\*The required Transcript will need to be uploaded into the Documents Section as indicated below.

## You are required to submit the following: ALL TO BE UPLOADED INTO THE DOCUMENTS SECTION of your Student Profile:

- Essay: 500 word minimum for the Alumni Undergraduate Scholarship (those still working towards an undergraduate or associates degree, or professional licensure); -OR 1000 words minimum for the Alumni Advanced Degree Scholarship (Graduate/Doctorate students).
  ESSAY TOPIC for both: Discuss how your interest in your field or major developed and tell us about your current experience in the field – such as volunteer work or internships – and what you gained from this involvement. (For prior scholarship recipients a new essay is required, explaining further experiences) \*\*Also include any post high school activities, awards, community service, etc you are or have been involved with.
- 2) Transcript most recent, showing credits earned thus far and GPA for both scholarship applicants unofficial transcript is acceptable. A <u>cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required to apply</u>. <u>Must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0</u> in order to claim your scholarship, as well.
- 3) Degree Received (<u>ONLY</u> for the Advance Degree Scholarship) if not earned by the application deadline, it will be required prior to any monetary award distribution. Make note of when the degree will be earned in your essay. If awarded the scholarship, please submit proof of degree when received.
- 4) Acceptance Letter to the Advanced Degree Program (<u>ONLY</u> for the Advance Degree Scholarship) if not accepted at the time of application deadline, it will be required prior to any monetary award distribution. Make note of the school and program to which you have applied to, or plan to apply to, in your essay.

\*\*To complete the application process, you must click the My Scholarships. You will be asked to answer a question. Click "yes" if you have completed entering the required information. Click Submit. You must then click the Apply next to the scholarship you want to apply for, then answer one final question. You will receive a confirmation email that you have successfully applied for the scholarship. Deadline is April 1, 2024 at 11:59pm.
