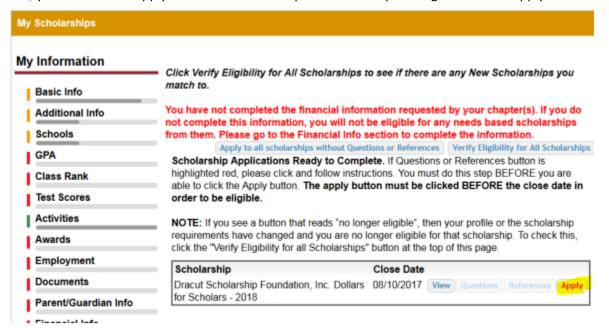
- 7. They will email you with a computer-generated password. It will ask you to change the password.

- 9. Click on "Search for Scholarships"



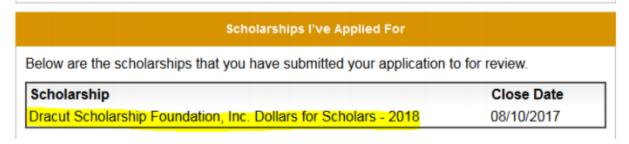
10. The DSF customized questions will come up. If you have been a student at Dracut High for grades 11 & 12, click YES, then Submit
