<u>Love for Children:</u> Students must be pursuing a career working directly with children. Examples such as Elementary Education, Child Development, Pediatrics, or Child Psychology.

<u>School Spirit:</u> Student who has fostered school spirit through active participation in Le Sueur-Henderson School Activities. A short letter of recommendation is required. "Please describe what school spirit means to you and tell us how you have demonstrated your school spirit at LS-H". Recipients will be determined by school staff.

<u>Technical College:</u> A GPA of 2.0 or above and attending a Two-year College OR Vocational-Technical School.

#### Angels Amongst Us - Fine Arts

Student is currently involved in Fine Arts attending a two-year community college/vocational school with preference given for someone going into the Fine Arts (Theatre, Band, Choir, Speech, etc). A GPA of 2.0 or above is required.

## Angels Amongst Us - Student Involvement

Student must be involved in one or more extra-curricular activities each year of high school and have a GPA of 3.0 or better.

- \*Double check email addresses for your Transcript request and Reference Request. Follow-up with those people prior to the deadline if not completed.
- \*Contact References sooner rather than later.
