Sandi is a graduate of UMass Amherst and received her MSW in social work from Smith College. She worked for the Monroe County Department of Children's Services in Rochester, NY, before moving back to Massachusetts where she became one of the original members of the Lynn Community Counseling Center (now the Lynn Community Health and Counseling Center) as a psychiatric social worker. She served as a clinical social worker at New England Memorial Hospital in Stoneham before starting her private practice in clinical social work in 1985, specializing in the treatment of adolescents. She truly loved this work until her retirement in 2017.
