Stanley K. Smith fought with the United States Army in France in World War I. After the war, he became a Charter Member of American Legion Post #1 in Paris, France. When he returned to Westfield, Stanley became a Charter Member of American Legion Post 124. He was the first Commander of the post in 1919, and participated in post activities for many years.

Stanley's estate donated the basic funding for this scholarship.
Later, his daughter and son provided additional funding so their father would be remembered in perpetuity.
