If your student is under 18, they can not complete their scholarship application process without your permission. Please click the "grant consent" button below to allow your student to compete for scholarship money available through Scholarship America and its partners.

In order for your student to compete for scholarships based on financial need, you must provide family financial information. This information will be kept strictly confidential and will not be viewable by anyone but you. The information will be used in calculations (similar to the FAFSA) to develop an expected family contribution which will be used to determine relative need. The only number visible to anyone other than you will be that final expected family contribution amount.

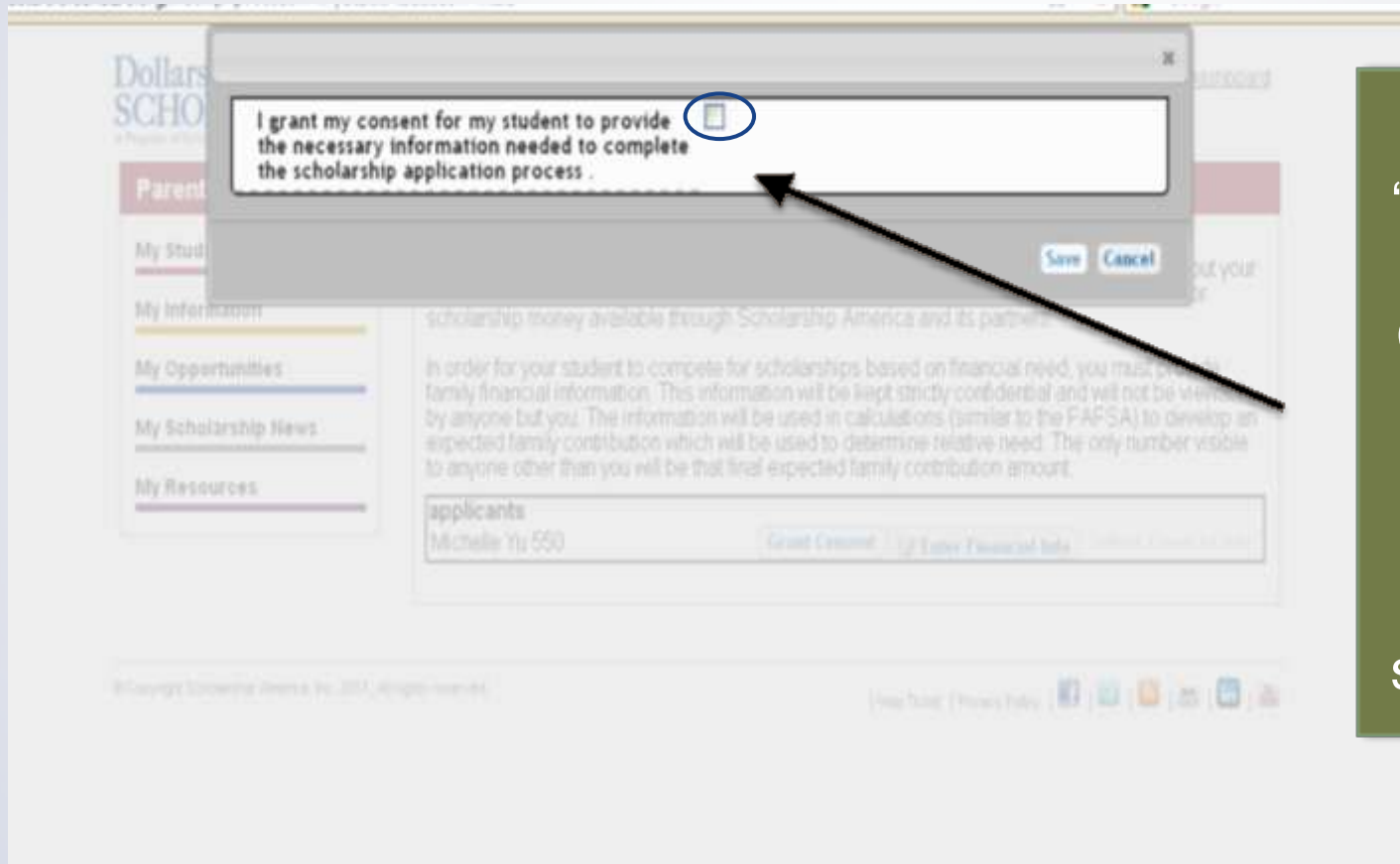
